The Court doth approve Joseph H. Prince its agent to purchase of Messrs. Peckham, Stewart & Hooper copies of the Washington Smelter Saltworks since there was four hundred bushels of salt to be distributed among the inhabitants of this County for which purpose the said Prince is authorized to draw on the Sheriff for any amount or he hands due the County and further to borrow of any of the Banks of the Commonwealth or from any individual or individuals any amount necessary for the purchase & transportation of the salt

Absent Thos J. Postler Robt S. Barnes Roy. C. Woodall Wm. C. Deal Justices -

It appearing to the Court that there is a balance due from James B. Vugheant Comptroller of Wickham H. Vugheant due in his last report. It is ordered that he remit the said balance or any other moneys coming to his hands as Virginia State bonds and make report to this Court -

This day came B. L. Barnes who alleges that he is aggrieved by an entry and books of personal property made by James M. Bell Commissioner of the Revenue for said County on the year 1861 whereby he is charged with \$2500 taxes for the year 1861 on 7 Slaves. 1 White male over 21 years of age & \$538 personal property, moneys & credits. and therefore the said B. L. Barnes moved this Court to adjourn him from the payment of \$10.55 out part of the taxes so erroneously charged against him for said year: which motion was defended by the attorney for the Commonwealth for said County and the said James M. Bell the said B. L. Barnes being in the office of the said Commissioner of the Revenue at the time of the making of the County Commissioner who made the appraisement, was examined as to all things touching the application. And it appears that not two years have elapsed since the books in which said erroneous entry has been made was certified by the Clerk of the Court of this County, and that application for redress against the erroneous entry was made on the day for the first time. On consideration thereof and from the facts proved, the Court is satisfied that the said B. L. Barnes is erroneously charged on said books with taxes amounting to \$10.55. Whereupon it is ordered that the said B. L. Barnes be acquitted from the payment of \$10.55 taxes so erroneously charged of and already paid, and if paid that it be refunded to him -
