

Resolved at a Court held the 1st day of July in the year 1862, in the said County, Did solemnly adjourn, and adjourned the Slaves Garrison, a British, Willard, Dick, and Red, the property of Jesse Little to abscond and escape from their master the said Jesse Little was this day sent to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and, being arraigned, pleaded not guilty, And the Court having heard the evidence and unanimity of opinion that the said Washington Brown is guilty of the offence wherein he stands charged, therefore it is ordered by the Court that the said Washington Brown be sold into absolute slavery. It appearing to the Court that the said Washington Brown has committed an offence punishable by confinement in the Penitentiary, and it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County shall proceed to sell the said Washington Brown after the order and in the manner prescribed for the sale of Slaves determined a Court upon. And thereupon the said Washington Brown is remanded to jail.

On the motion of John W. Munroe who made oath according to law and together with H. D. Soper and Willard Thomas his co-defendants (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a bond with penalty of Eight Hundred Dollars conditioned according to law, Confessed is granted the said John W. Munroe for obtaining letters of Administration on the Estate of John H. Williams, Decd. in due form.

Ordered that a Jace S. Soper, Lewis Bonnet, J. D. Soper and A. K. Stephenson, or any three of them being sworn before a J. C. of the peace for the purpose do appraise all the goods and chattels of John H. Williams decd. that may be produced to them and return the said appraisement to the Court of this Court.

Ordered that the Account of L. R. Edwards, Clerk of this Court amounting to \$700 - be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment.

Ordered that Henry W. Vick Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Stephen Stephenson decd. to be administered according to law.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County discontinue all the acting Justices of the peace of this County to the next term of this Court for War purposes.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
