Ordered that the agents of this County appointed under an order
 of this Court at the June term 1861, to negotiate a loan of money
 for the purpose of running the Mill & land & volunteers of this
 County, settle and account of their transactions before one of
 the Commissioners of this Court return the same to this Court
 at the December term next of this Court.

Ordered That John Cobb, Henry M. Bude, James S. Bayard,
 William E. Gay and Seth H. Bishop four Justices Commissioners
 of this County examine the vouchers and budgets in the same
 relating to the bridge across Nottoway river at Portsmouth
 and provide for and receive sealed proposals for the rebuilding
 and repairs of the same and return them to the next term
 of this Court, and it is ordered that the Sheriff of this
 County summon all the acting Justices of this County to the
 next term of this Court to receive and examine the said
 proposals and determine which, if any, of said proposals
 they will accept.

Abolish all the Justices except Samuel B. Kello presiding Justice
 John J. Holmes, James Holmes and Benjamin F. McNeill
 Justices.

On the motion of Henry M. Bude guardian for Jane and Catharine
 Briggs. It appearing to the Court that there is a balance in
 his hands due his said wife, it is ordered that he be
 authorized to invest the said balance or any portion thereof
 in six per cent Virginia or North Carolina State bonds and
 report to this Court.

On the motion of John S. Powell guardian for Elizabeth Beldie
 Moore. It appearing to the Court that there is a balance of
 bond of \$500.00 in his hands due his said ward, it is ordered that
 he be authorized to invest the said balance or any portion
 thereof in six per cent Virginia State bonds and report
 to this Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County, George W. Vink take
 into his hands the estate of William S. Leonard Esq.
 administered according to law.

On the motion of Joseph J. Harris. It is ordered that the Sheriff
 of this County summon all the acting Justices of this County to the
 next term of this Court to settle and consider the
 propriety of establishing a ferry across Black Water river
