competent witnesses, said Darden & Bryant to be correct. And James J.
Darden the executor therein named having refused to take upon himself
the burden of the executorship thereof or any part, on the oaths of
William A. Worrell who made oath according to law and together
with James J. Worrell, his security, (who justified on oath as
to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged abroad in the
presence of two witnesses, William A. Worrell according to law,
beneficiaries is granted here for obtaining letters of administration
thereon in the estate of the said Casswell Worrell dec'd. in due form.

Ordered that James J. Darden, James J. Worrell, Sam. Virginian,
and John Worrell or any three of them being sworn for purposes
before a justice of the peace, do appraise all the goods
and chattels of Casswell Worrell dec'd. that may be produced
to them and make due return of the same.
