

and Harrison S. Pope are agents of this County to negotiate and loan for and in the name of this County of the sum of ten thousand Dollars payable in eight equal annual installments, the first payment to become due the first day of January 1864, bearing interest at the rate of six per hundred per annum payable semiannually, and for that purpose the said agents or any three of them are authorized to sell the lands of this County signed and sealed by the said agents, or any three of them, and countersigned by the preceding Justice of this County in sums of not less than five hundred Dollars and with the amount of money thus raised purchase cloth shoes & other necessaries for the use and comfort of the Soldiers from this County in the Army of the Confederate States.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County summon all the acting Justices of this County to the next term of this Court for military purposes and for the purpose of ratifying the action of the Board this day taken to raise money to cloth and shoe the Soldiers from this County in the Army of the Confederate States.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
