On motion of Phineas M. Bailey, a party interested. The Court doth order that Mary L. Bailey be appointed the trustee in place of Joseph T. Summerville dec^d. in a certain deed of trust executed by Phineas M. Bailey to Joseph T. Summerville trustee concerning land &c for the benefit of the said Phineas M. Bailey's children.

On motion of Delaware Webb, an infant by W^m C. Gayther her friend and attorney at law of William Webb dec^d. The Court doth adjudge, order and decree that John R. Daugherty, Collin Hicks and Willey Sevenskins who are hereby appointed Special Commissioners for that purpose and any two of whom may and shall after reasonable notice to all the parties interested proceed to assign to Nancy J. Webb her mother or third in right of all the lands whereof her husband William Webb dec^d. seized, and proper for &c if necessary employing a surveyor for the purpose and report their proceedings to Court in order to a further decree.

On the petition of Eliza J. Williams Curator of Catharine Williams's selling flock that he had sold a Slave belonging to his said ward &c. The Court after hearing the petition of Eliza Williams, doth adjudge, order and decree that the sale made by him of the said Slave belonging to Catharine Williams be confirmed, and direct that after the payment of the expenses of the sale to her the residue of the purchase money as he does the other money belonging to his ward Catharine Williams.

The County Commissioners of this County this day returned an account of their transactions, which was received and ordered to be filed and that the duties of said Commissioners cease from this day.
