

Wm. W. Co. disappointed a Commissioner of this land to receive in the city of Schenectady the Salt to be used by the Governor for the use of the Citizens of this County, and he is authorized to draw on the Sheriff of this County for the amount of money that may be necessary to pay for the same, and that he was first to such of the Citizens as have not received any Salt in the same proportion that the first class received Salt as distributed and then to all the Citizens alike at the rate of eight cents a pound.

Ordered That Joseph W. Driscoll the Commissioner appointed by this land to purchase Salt for this land, pay over to the Sheriff of this County twenty five hundred Dollars to be accounted for by him.

The Commissioner's report of a Vision of the Slave belonging to Georgiana Bailey died was this day returned at the request of the parties interested and ordered to be recorded.

The last Will and Testament of Mary Anne Joyner died was this day proved by the oaths of Samuel Sells and Golden Hutchins, the subscribing witnesses thereof and ordered to be recorded.

The Denunciation of Edith Wills of the provision made for her in the will of her husband James Wills died acknowledged before Joshua Butler a Justice of the peace of this County was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the application of George W. Wills to establish a ferry across Blackwater river at Grosvenor Bridge. His reasons appearing to the land this application is continued until the next term of this land, and on the motion of the said George W. Wills it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County summon all the acting Justices of this County to the next term to take into consideration the said application.
