

and James Holman whose duties as agents cover the State of Georgia for the necessities of the families of the soldiers in this County for the way required that each agent be allowed to expend not more than three hundred Dollars in his District without authority from this Court, and the same agents are invested with all the powers of the former Courts of the County under the order of this Court made at the June Term of this Court 1861 to raise money for that purpose.

Bellings Amended Decr 1st.

On the motion of E. H. Gray, guardian of George A. Holman he is allowed to expend the sum of \$1500.00 of the principal of his widow's estate and he is authorized to allow her wages to take with him to his farm six of his negroes in having cattle.

The last Will and Testament of Ossian A. Gardner was duly proved by the oaths of Miss J. Davis and Madison Green the Subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And in the twinkling of Arlington Gardner the executor therein named who made oath and together with James Hendry and Leslie McRae, his Sureties (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars conditioned according to law. Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Owing this Miss J. Davis, Col. Sperry, Wm. G. Stephen and Richard Stephenson, or any three of them being ~~any two~~ fully the Sureties do appraise all the goods & chattels of Ossian A. Gardner deceased that may be produced to them and make the return of the same.

Ordered that George W. Vick, Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Benjamin J. Randal Esq. Admonished according to law.

And in the twinkling of Joseph H. Gaines, the Sureties thereto named who made oath and together with Joseph W. Black and Joshua V. Clegg, his Sureties, did
