

At a monthly Term of the County Court of Guilford County held at the Court house thereof  
on Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> day of January 1863.

Present Peter J. Holmes - Elliott S. Briggs - J. P. W. Worrell - Justice.

The Clerk this day returned a list of all writings admitted to record during the last past session  
of this Court under chapters 121 of the Code of Virginia, which list being made to the  
Court is ordered to be inserted in the minutes and is as follows, to wit:

Deed of bargain & sale dated 1<sup>st</sup> January 1861 between Benjamin J. Pope & others & others  
to Elliott H. Pope conveying land was admitted to record December 15<sup>th</sup> 1862

Deed of bargain & sale dated 23<sup>rd</sup> August 1853 between Elizabeth D. & others  
to George H. Doughty, conveying land & personal estate was admitted to record December  
15<sup>th</sup> 1862

Deed of bargain & sale dated 1<sup>st</sup> day of the first month 1861 from Robert P. Dabbs &  
Charlotte H. his wife to Samuel Doughty, conveying land was admitted to record December  
15<sup>th</sup> 1862

Mortgage Contract dated 10<sup>th</sup> December 1862 between Stephen Henderson & others  
James Cobb by which the said Cobb retains all the property real & personal of which this  
is property for her and her heirs and assigns with power to dispose of all or any part of it  
by will - was admitted to record December 16<sup>th</sup> 1862

Deed of bargain & sale dated 6<sup>th</sup> January 1862 from W. W. Briggs Commissioner to  
Samuel Wells, conveying real estate was admitted to record January 1<sup>st</sup> 1863.

The Account of Thomas B. Worrell Trustee of a fund of Trust executed by John L. Ray  
during his life and afterwards in the Clerk's Office and there being no exception thereto was  
confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

The Account of Charles Sumner Bond's administration on William Bond's Estate during his  
life and afterwards in the Clerk's Office and there being no exception thereto was confirmed  
and ordered to be recorded.

On motion of J. P. Edwards he is exempted from the payment of being here for not  
yet going his being exempted.

Ordered that James Downing & Robert Rowland two of the Commissioners of said  
County be and they are to collect the taxes of said County and forthwith return a bill  
when completed and make report to Court.

On motion of Leonard C. Cobb guardian of Richard P. Vaughan he is allowed to  
repeal the said Richard's will and all the provisions of the principal of the said will and to sell the  
said Richard's real and personal estate.
