Present Saml D Kelle presiding Justice. Messrs Law & John Parker Justices.

The Clerk this day returned a list of all writings admitted to record in this Court during or since the last preceding term under Chapter 126 of the Code of Virginia, which list being read to the Court is ordered to be mounted in the minutes and is as follows, to wit:

Deed of bargain and sale dated 6th January 1863 from Benjamin J. Bryant & wife to Caroline W. Keefe, conveying land, was admitted to Record the 19th day of January 1863.

Deed of bargain and sale dated 20th January 1863 from William Lambford and William Lambford to William Webb, conveying land, was admitted to record the 9th day of February 1863.

The Account of George W. Vick's administration on the estate of Levi Reed dec^d as also a report of the debts and demands against the said estate having been one month and upwards in the Clerk's Office and there being no exception thereto were examined and ordered to be recorded.

The Account of George W. Vick's administration on the estate of Atallah Whitfield dec^d as also the account of the debts and demands outstanding against the said estate having been one month and upwards in the Clerk's Office and there being no exception thereto were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded and it is ordered that the said George W. Vick administrator as aforesaid pay \$5.71 with interest thereon from October 21st 1862 to James J. Davidson towards the payment of his debt reported against the said estate.

The Account of George W. Vick's administration on the estate of William J. Porter dec^d as also the account of the debts and demands outstanding against the said estate having been one month and upwards in the Clerk's Office and there being no exception thereto, were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded and it is ordered that the said George W. Vick administrator as aforesaid out of the balance in his hands pay to James J. Davidson the sum of \$12.92 with interest thereon from the 1st of January 1863, to C. C. Davidson the sum of \$20.00 with interest thereon from the 1st day of January 1863, in satisfaction of their debts reported against the said estate.

The Account of George W. Vick's administration on the estate of James H. Parvett's dec^d as also the account of the debts and demands outstanding against the said estate having been one month and upwards in the Clerk's Office and there being no exception thereto, were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded, and it is ordered that the said George W. Vick administrator as aforesaid pay to Davis Vick the sum of \$6.21 also the further sum of \$6.53 and to Atallah J. Davidson the sum of \$8.70 of their respective portions of the balance in his hands, with interest thereon from May 30th 1862.

The Account of George W. Vick's administration on the estate of Adam Scotchman dec^d as also the account of the debts and demands outstanding against the said estate having been one month and upwards in the Clerk's Office and there being no exception thereto, were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded and it is ordered that the said George W. Vick administrator as aforesaid out of the balance in his hands pay to Geo. C. Pope \$35.87 with interest on \$32.18 paid thereof from the 15th of November 1862, to Pope W. Woodard \$40.81 with interest on \$36.17 paid thereof from the 15th of November 1862, to St. P. Pope \$10.87 with interest on \$13.93 paid thereof from 15th of November 1862, to St. P. Pope \$27.63 paid thereof from 15th of November 1862, to Geo. C. Pope \$9.54 with interest on \$1.94 paid thereof from 15th of November 1862, to Benjamin J. Pope \$10.51 with interest on \$9.50.
