

At a Monthly Term of the County Court of Southampton County held at the Courthouse thereof on Monday the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February 1863.

Present Sam'l W. Wells President of Justice, Shagars Law & John Estlin Justices.

The Clerk this day returned a list of all writings admitted to record in this Court during or since the last preceding term under Chapter 12<sup>th</sup> of the Code of Virginia, which list being read to the Court is ordered to be recorded in the minutes and is as follows, to wit:

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated 6<sup>th</sup> January 1863 from Benjamin J. Bryant & wife to Caroline H. Thorpe, conveying land, was admitted to Record the 19<sup>th</sup> day of January 1863.

Deed of Bargain and Sale, dated 20<sup>th</sup> January 1863 from Abram Lambford and William Lambford to William Bell, conveying land was admitted to record the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February 1863.

The Account of George W. Vick administrator as aforesaid out of the balance in his hands pay to James J. Dardar the sum of \$14.92 with interest thereon from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1863, to C. E. Darden the sum of \$20.00 with interest thereon from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1863, in satisfaction of this debt reported against the said estate.

The Account of George W. Vick's administration on the estate of James H. Barrett do<sup>r</sup> as also the account of the debt and demands outstanding against the said estate having law one month and upwards in the Clerk's Office and there being no exception thereto, were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded and it is ordered that the said George W. Vick administrator as aforesaid out of the balance in his hands pay to Mrs. Vick the sum of \$6.24 also the further sum of \$6.53, and to Rufus J. Dardar the sum of \$3.70 of their respective portions of the balance in his hands, with interest thereon from May 30<sup>th</sup> 1862.

Vick's administration on the estate of Adam Scatchens do<sup>r</sup> as also the account of the debt and demands outstanding against the said estate having law one month and upwards in the Clerk's Office and there being no exception thereto, were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded and it is ordered that the said George W. Vick administrator as aforesaid out of the balance in his hands pay to Geo. C. Peper \$35.87 with interest on \$32.18 part thereof from the 1<sup>st</sup> November 1862, to Geo. C. Peper \$40.31 with interest on \$36.17 part thereof from the 1<sup>st</sup> November 1862, to Geo. C. Peper \$14.71 with interest on \$13.23 part thereof from 1<sup>st</sup> November 1862, to H. P. Peper \$130.87 with interest on \$27.63 part thereof from 1<sup>st</sup> November 1862, to Geo. C. Peper \$3.24 with interest on \$1.94 part thereof from 1<sup>st</sup> November 1862, to Benjamin J. Peper \$14.51 with interest on \$9.50,
