Whereas two deeds of Trust having been executed by Phineas A. Bailey, the date whereof not collected, as the same with the other records, of the County of South-west, having been removed, in consequence of the proximity of the public enemy, coming, certain property real & personal to J. S. H. Summrell trustee for the benefit of said Phineas & others And whereas the said J. S. H. Summrell being dead, the said appointed Henry L. Bailey, in the place of the said Summrell to execute the said trust. And thereupon to act, the parties concerning their interest under the said deed of public officers, appeared without advice & did appoint Samuel H. Holmes trustee in the premises Whereupon the said Holmes did proceed to sell the said property in the deeds of trust mentioned, as will appear by his account of sales herewith filed & ordered to be entered & recorded, and paid the debt due to Isaac as will also appear by his bond secured by said deed also returned therewith filed. And it appearing that Thaddeus Bailey, Joseph Bailey, Edgar Bailey & Dennis Bailey who being minors are entitled to with Phineas A. Bailey Jr. & Henry L. Bailey the two last being entitled to the balance in the hands of the said J. S. H. Summrell trustee, the said Henry L. Bailey acting on behalf of said J. S. H. being of opinion that the exigencies of the times, and the condition of the parties (the minor parties being actually suffering for food) interested demanded immediate action, the said parties being able thereto, did hereby ratify the appointment of the said Holmes as trustee & did appoint him and the Court dole further ratify and confirm the sale made by him, and doth authorize him to execute all deeds & papers that may be necessary to convey title to the property sold. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that a compromise of this Court, with the transactions of said trustee in the premises & ascertain the amounts severally due to the parties aforesaid entitled to the said balance remaining in the hands of the said trustee and make report to Court with such other matters as may be required by the parties to be stated or as he may deem pertinent.
