Powell who stands charged with a felony by her commission in the County and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this town that the said George did on the 14 day of February in the year 1863 in the day time maliciously burn the dwelling house of Margaret Atwood in the said County was this day set under, in custody of the Sheriff of this County and Edward H. Mafenburgh being attorney by the Court at her Command and the said Slave George being therupon arraigned pleaded not guilty and the Court having heard the evidence is of opinion that the said George is not guilty of the felony of which he stands charged and therefore proclamation being made at the same a mid morning further appearing or being alleged against the said George and is ordered that she be discharged from custody.

Dixey a slave the property of Margaret Atwood who stands charged with a felony by his commission within County and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this town that the said Dixey did on the 16 day of February 1863 in the day time maliciously burn the dwelling house of Margaret Atwood in the said County was this day set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County Whereupon the attorney for the Commonwealth with the assent of the Court hath he will not prosecute against the said Dixey for the felony aforesaid Therefore it is ordered by the Court she said Dixey be discharged from further prosecution for said felony and therupon she is discharged from custody.

On motion of Wm H Lummerall Guardian of Richard S Boykin Ordered that she be charged to meet the money in his hands belonging to his ward in Virginia for rent State Stock & Bond stock & his services

The Court doth appoint A. S. H. Burge Esq. of the Estate of Mary Brainerd Esq. standing her Will before her administration on her estate augmented and therupon he together with Thos J. Brister his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) interdicts and acknowledges a bond in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned according to law.
