Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to attend on the first day of the next Term of this Court to consider such matters as may be brought before them relative to the soldiers from this County in the Confederate Army or their families or any matter connected in any way with the war with the United States and to take into consideration the property of the County, ^{including} currency notes or bills of and under the denomination one dollar as provided by an act of Assembly entitled "An ^{Act to provide} a currency of notes of less denomination than

one dollar" passed March 29 1862.

Ordered that the Salt Commissioners of this County be authority ed to sell at public Auction at the Courthouse of this County on the first day of the next Term of this Court to the highest bidder among the Citizens of this County any balance of the State Salt then remaining on hand.

Above all the Justices except Sam'l B. Kelly, Presiding Justice and James Holmes and Thomas J. Dutton Justices.

R. H. Pittet is appointed Salt Commissioner to receive and report and amongst the Citizens of this County any Salt that may be required to make fires belonging to this County here after.

Wm' M. Reaton, George C. Sibley, two of the Salt Commissioners of this County this Day made a report of their transactions up to this time showing a balance in their hands of \$2589.98⁴ which by order of the Court is this day given over to the Sheriff of this County who is ordered to account for the same on his return settlement with the County.
