Ordered that the Salt Commissioners of this County be authorized to sell at public Auction at the Courthouse of this County on the first day of the next Term of this Court to the highest bidder amongst the citizens of this County any balance of the State Salt then remaining on hand.

Abund all the Justices except Saml. B. Kello presiding Justice and James Holmes and Thomas J. Dutton Justices.

R. H. Dutton is appointed Salt Commissioner to receive and appraise and amongst the citizens of this County any Salt that may be received at Warfield's belonging to this County hereafter.

Robert M. Dutton & George C. Dole, two of the Salt Commissioners of this County this day made a report of their transactions up to this time showing a balance in their hands of \$2589.96 1/4 which by order of the Court is this day paid over to the Sheriff of this County who is ordered to account for the same in his future settlement with the County.
