 that sum a fee of \$500.00 each.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting partners of the
 County to the next term of this Court to be held on the 1st day of
 as being brought before them relative to the same. And
 this Court in the Confederate Army or their families
 and interests in any way with the war with the
 and to be into consideration the property of these and
 issuing currency notes in bills of and under the
 of one dollar as provided by an act of Assembly
 the act to provide a currency of notes of the denomination
 that one dollar paper March 27. 1862.

Ordered that the Salt Commissioners of this County in any
 future sales of Salt belonging to that County charge for
 thereon at the rate of ten cents per pound.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
