

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the long bridge over Maysburg's Mill run in & receive the same when completed, this day order their report which is ordered to be filed.

Ordered that W. S. Harris and James R. Jopson two of the Commissioners of roads of this County, let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge near Mrs. Charlotte Leighs, also the repairs of the bridge near Hayline Depot over Tarras Creek and repair the same when complete.

The warrant of the Court is granted Suchy Phillips a negro slave to Johna his child to Anthony, Isaac & Nancy the wife of Isaac & Nancy \$10.00 a year and for the service of Isaac & Nancy \$5.00 a year each except for the first year which is to be paid to the apprentices.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County, summon all the acting Justices of this County to the next term of this Court to lay and offer to the County all the evidence such matters as may be brought before them relative to the soldiers from this County in the late Civil War & their families or any matter connected in any way with the war with the United States and to take into consideration the propriety of this County issuing currency notes or bills of and under the Decree of the Court of the Dollar as provided by an act of Assembly entitled "An act to provide a currency of notes of less denomination than Five Dollars passed March 29, 1862."

On the motion of Jonathan Dutton who made oath and entered into an acknowledgment of bond in the penalty of four hundred Dollars but without binding the Court not requiring any of them conditions according to law Certificate is granted him for obtaining bills of administration on the estate of Martha J. Dutton deceased in due form.

Robert S. Dutton one of the Salt Commissioners of this County this day made a report of his transactions showing the sum of \$13859.24 to be in his hands due the County which he is ordered to pay over to Joseph St. Denis the Salt purchasing agent of this County, who is to account for the same of so much thereof as may be granted to the County that he may receive in his future settlement with the County.
