Wm H. Giffen & Henry S. Menard, the Commissioners in Chancery in this Court having returned to the County from service in the Confederate States Army, &c. report that the order of Court made at the term ended 1862 appointing James M. Parker, a Commissioner in Chancery in this Court during their absence, is ascertained and recorded.

On the motion of Delamater Webb an infant by Wm E. his next friend and her at law of William Webb, dec'd the Commissioners in this cause this day made their report.

The last will and testament of Mary Bradshaw dec'd was this day proved by the oaths of John A. Hendley and Margaret Hendley, the subscribing witnesses thereof and Christopher Adams to be recorded. And on the return of James Hendley, the executor thereof named who made oath and together with Augustus Gardner and William Kitchen his co-executors were put upon their oath as to their sufficiency & status and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred Dollars conditioned according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that A. Gardner, John Hendley and W. Kitchen being sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of Mary Bradshaw dec'd that may be produced to them and make the return of the same.

John J. Johnson is appointed the agent of this County to receive a loan for and in the name of this County of the sum of twelve thousand Dollars for the purpose of purchasing land for the use of the inhabitants of this County and he is authorized to issue the notes of this County for the same & any part thereof to be counter-signed by the presiding Justice of this Court, payable on demand with interest from date in current funds or in such funds as may be receivable for public taxes.

The Sheriff this day returned three lists of delinquent County taxes one amounting to \$1522.24 of another amounting to \$152.13 of another amounting to \$18.04 of which were returned and ordered to be paid.
