Parker a special Commissioner to continue in office until the further order of the Court and thereupon he took the oath of office -

On the motion of J. Farrell Turner who made oath and together with attorney A. James his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned according to law certified to him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edward Turner deceased in due form

Beale as that may be produced or shown to them and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court

On the motion of James D. McPherson guardian of James P. McPherson he is allowed to deposit three hundred dollars of the principal of his said ward's estate for their support and education of the said ward this year

Jensen were sworn a grand jury of inquest for the body of this County and having received their charges with law and after some time returned and presented (these were the presentments) and the said grand jury having nothing further to present was discharged -
