

At a County Court for the County of Southampton convened and held at the Courthouse steps of our
Tuesday the 15 day of September 1863 to carry into effect the requisition of the Governor made under an
Act of Assembly passed March 13, 1863 entitled "An Act to Amend and renew and act further to provide
for the Public Service passed October 3, 1862.

This Court now Whereas the Justice of the Peace of Southampton County having been
summoned for compliance with the requisition from the Governor of this State did about August 30
1863 to send a portion of the Slave labor to work upon public works nine of them number did on
the 15 day of September 1863 meet accordingly and after a full investigation of the
condition of the County pass unanimously the following resolution - That with all due respect
to the Confederate Government and an entire willingness to comply with the requisition they do
therefore order their Agent P. J. Holmes to go to Richmond in person before the Governor at
full exposition of the condition of the County with the conviction and hope that when fully
understood by him he will release the County from this draft for labor as the law authorizes
him to do.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Monday next ten o'clock. A. M.
