The Commissioners for this cause this day made their report.

John Stimpfield is appointed Surveyor of the Roads from Cypress Swamp to Dick's Swamp in the road of Richard D. Cather owned and it is ordered that the usual bonds be made thereon.

William G. Myrick is appointed Surveyor of the road from Cypress Swamp to the State line in the road of Richard Ferguson owned and it is ordered that the usual bonds be made thereon.

Ordered that the Commissioner appointed to provide for the families of the poor soldiers from this County be authorized to expend the sum of three hundred dollars ^{and twenty} in addition to the amount heretofore authorized eight dollars per ^{each} soldier having heretofore been authorized to expend that amount.

Ordered that the Sheriff out of the money ^{orderly} from the sale of salt in his hands pay of Joseph St. Pierre the sum of \$1500 to pay for salt huckeys purchased for the use of the citizens of this County.

Collin & Stew. James Gray & Peter Brattle. On the motion of Samuel Hill Sheriff of this County are permitted to qualify as his Deputy, it appearing to the Court that they are men of honesty and good character and therewith they take the several oaths prescribed by law.

The Committee heretofore appointed for clothing the Soldiers from this County this day made their report which is as follows:

On the motion of Henry Gray an infant by George W. Vick her next friend, the Court doth adjudge and decree that Samuel Hill, Henry Ferguson, and George St. Pierre who are hereby appointed special Commissioners for that purpose shall after reasonable notice to attorney Gray the widow provide ballot to attorney Gray widow of James Gray, &c. one third in value of all the lands whereof James Gray died seized and possessed, if necessary employ a competent Surveyor for that purpose and report to Court in order to a final decree.

James Barnes executor of Samuel W. Hill deceased M^r and Mary L. Hill living, filed his petition asking an Order of the Court directing him how to invest the funds in his hands belonging to his said Masters, the Court doth adjudge and decree that the said James Barnes invest the sum of \$1200 for Samuel W. the sum of \$1200 for Cornelia W. and the sum of \$1200 for Henry L. Hill in Confederate States Stock or Virginia or North Carolina State Stock as to how may best best taking the bonds payable to him as executor and collecting of the interest annually and account for the same.

James Barnes Executor of Jacob Barnes late having filed his petition asking directions how to invest the funds in his hands belonging to Jacob Barnes estate the Court doth order and decree that the said Barnes invest the sum of \$900 either in Confederate States Stock or Virginia or North Carolina State Stock as to how may best best taking the bonds payable to him as executor and collecting of the interest annually and account for the same.

On the motion of John H. Edward A. Adalaisde R. Robert W. & Roger Gardner infants and heirs at law of Anna M. Gardner deceased by W^m W. Cobb their next friend it is ordered that Eddy Spring, Esqⁿ Spring, Walter Stephen are to set and appear to Cornelia C. Gardner widow of the said Anna M. Gardner to answer the same.
