The Commissioners in this cause this day made their report.

John H. Springfield is appointed Surveyor of the Road from Cypress Swamp to Dick's Swamp in the name of John H. D. Cather excused and it is ordered that the usual bonds be made thereon.

William Colquhoun is appointed Surveyor of the road ^{from} Cypress Swamp to the State line in the name of Richard Frequent excused and it is ordered that the usual bonds be made thereon.

Ordered that the Committee appointed to provide for the families of the poor soldiers from this County be authorized to expend the sum of three hundred dollars ^{in and distinct} in addition to the amount heretofore authorized except distinct and that distinct having heretofore been authorized to expend that amount.

Ordered that the Sheriff out of the moneys coming from the sale of salt in his hands pay of Joseph H. James the sum of \$1500. to pay for salt heretofore purchased for the use of the citizens of this County.

Collier, Kitchin, James Gurley & John Battle on the motion of Samuel Wells Sheriff of this County are permitted to qualify as his Deputies, it appearing to the Court that they are men of honesty and good demeanor and therefore they into the several oaths prescribed by law.

The Committee heretofore appointed for clothing the Soldiers from this County this day made their report which is annexed to be filed.

On the motion of Henry Gray an infant by George W. Vick her next friend, the Court with advice order and decree that Mills Gray Henry Frequent, and George H. Biggs who are heretofore appointed Special Commissioners for that purpose shall after reasonable notice to Henry Gray the widow proceed to settle to Henry Gray widow of James Gray her one third in value of all the lands whereof James Gray died Seized and possessed, if necessary employ a competent Surveyor for that purpose and report to Court in order to a final decree.

James Barnes guardian of Samuel W. Hill Caroline W. and Henry I. Hill having filed his petition asking an Order of the Court directing him how to invest the funds in his hands belonging to his said wards. The Court with advice order and decree that the said James Barnes invest the sum of \$1200. for Samuel W. the sum of \$1200. for Caroline W. and the like sum of \$1200. for Henry I. Hill in Confederate States Stock or Virginia or North Carolina State Stocks as to him may seem best and collect the interest annually and account for the same.

James Barnes Executor of Jacob Barnes Jr. having filed his petition asking directions how to invest the funds in his hands belonging to Jacob Barnes estate the Court with advice order and decree that the said Barnes invest the sum of \$1200. either in Confederate States Stock or Virginia or North Carolina State Stock as to him may seem best taking the bonds payable to him as executor and collecting the interest annually and account for the same.
