

At a Quarterly Term of the County Court of Southampton County held at the Courthouse
on Monday the 16th day of November 1863.
Present: Samuel B. Helle Presiding Justice. W. Lane Griffis,
Thomas Vaughan Justice.

The Clerk returned a list of all writings admitted to record in this Court or by the Sheriff's Office during or since the last preceding term of this Court under Chapter 83d of the Code of Virginia, which list being read to the Court is ordered to be inserted in the minutes and is in these words as follows:

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated 30 August 1862 from James Jones Esq. 18 of Southampton County to Thomas Bramley, conveying real estate, was admitted to Record No 10 October 1863.

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated 16 June 1863 from Lucy Board to Willis C. Williams, conveying real estate, was admitted to record 19 October 1863.

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated 16 October 1860 from Richard Dorett to Mary Williams, conveying real estate, was admitted to Record 19 October 1863.

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated 26 September 1863 from Sally A. Harris to Henry F. Williams, conveying real estate, was admitted to Record 19 October 1863.

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated 5th day of November 1863 from Dennis Bryant to John H. Williams, conveying real estate, was admitted to Record November 7th 1863.

The account of John Turner's administration and Attorney Turner's estate, of David Holmes' guardianship of Mary E. Cland and of John P. Cland having been examined and reported in the Clerk's Office and there being no objection thereto, was generally examined, confirmed and ordered to record.

On the motion of Mr. S. Gooding Esq. of Penwell Drawry Esq. Ordered that the will of George R. Turner die be committed to the hands of Samuel Helle Sheriff of the County for administration according to law.

Peter J. Holmes the agent appointed to negotiate a loan for the purchase of salt to be made a report which is ordered to be filed.

The Court acting under a joint Resolution of the General Assembly of Virginia of October 23rd 1863 directed that the districts of the Commissioners of the Revenue in the County be designated as follows to wit: That the district on the North side of Wicomico River and now known as Nottoway Parish be designated and hereafter known as District No. 1, and that the district on the South side of Nottoway River be designated and hereafter known as District No. 2. And it is further ordered that the Clerk of this Court report immediately to the Auditor of Public Acccounts the designation of the Districts of each of the names of the present Commissioners of each District.

On motion of Jas. W. T. Clements guardian of Andrew J. Prince. It is ordered that he be allowed to export \$175 of the principal of his said wife's estate for his support.
