conveying real estate, was admitted to Record November 7th 1863.

The Account of John Turner administrator on Mary Turner estate, of David H. Davis
guardian of Mary E. Gland and of John P. Gland having been examined and reported in the
Clerk's office and there being no objection thereto were severally examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Wm. S. Goodwyn Esq. of Cornwall Drawing do^r Ordered that the will
of George R. Turner do^r be committed to the hands of Samuel Kells Sheriff of the County for
administration according to law.

The Court acting under a joint Resolution of the General Assembly of Virginia adopted
October 25th 1863 hath added that the districts of the Commissioners of the Revenue in the
County be designated as follows to wit: That the district on the North side of Nottoway
River and now known as Nottoway Parish be designated and hence after known as District
No. 1. and that the district on the South side of Nottoway River be designated as
District No. 2. And it is further ordered that the Clerk of this Court report
immediately to the Auditor of Public Accounts the designation of the districts aforesaid and
the name of the present Commissioners of each District.
