the motion of George W. Wiley for leave to increase the rate of ferrage on his ferry over Blacket  
Water river at "Proctor's" land the court having measured the application with order  
that the order heretofore made establishing the rates of ferrage, be rescinded, and that the future  
rate thereof shall be as follows to wit

In a four horse wagon & driver \$1.50 For a two horse wagon & driver 90 cent. For any one horse vehicle  
& driver 50 cent. For a person on horseback 25 cent - foot passengers 15 cent, and for all other  
persons except drivers 10 cent.

On motion of George W. Wiley Ordered that James G. Jones, D. L. Ades & John Cobb  
one of the Commissioners of Roads in this County proceed to make the ferry landing at Proctor's Bridge  
where the said George W. Wiley proposes to change the road and report to the Court the conveniences and  
inconveniences that will result as to individuals as to the publick of the alteration to be made as proposed
