Davis his attorney-who justified me with as to his sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond & chaperon of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificated & granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of William V. Turner dec'd in due form -

Ordered the Road from the Blackhead signpost to James Pease gate be added to the rest of which George Pease is Surveyor.

Ordered that Peter J. Holmes who was appointed at August Court as the Agent of the County to my State a loan for me in the name of the County of the sum of twelve thousand dollars for the purpose of purchasing salt for the use of the inhabitants of this County is hereby authorized to borrow the further sum of five thousand dollars to pay the transportation of said Salt &c and has authority to fix the negotiable value of the County for the same or any part payment in ready money in current funds or in such funds as may be receivable in payment of Public Taxes and countersigned by the Presiding Justice -

Ordered that James G. Jones & D. S. D. do for the Commissioners of Roads for this County do let to the most under take the repair of Seabrook bridge, receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

On the motion of Joseph H. Prince Executor of Thophilus Adams dec'd his petition to the Judge of the Circuit Court of this County and the order of the judge thereon is ordered to intend and file minutes and is intituled words following to wit -

To the Honorable Richard H. Baker - Your petitioner Joseph H. Prince Executor of Thophilus Adams dec'd respectfully represents to your honor that as such fiduciary he has in his hands the sum of seventeen hundred (\$1700) dollars which he is unable to lend out & pay over to the party entitled (the County an infant and no guardian yet appointed) Your petitioner therefore asks that your honor make an order authorizing him to invest the said sum of \$1700 in interest bearing bonds, or certificates of the Confederate States or of the State of Virginia - Joseph H. Prince Esq. of This Adams dec'd

Upon the petition of Joseph H. Prince Executor of Thophilus Adams dec'd representing that as such Executor he is in possession of the sum of seventeen hundred dollars (\$1700) which he is unable to pay over to the party entitled, being an infant and that he desires to invest this sum pursuant to the Act of Assembly Chap. March 5. 1863, it is therefore ordered that the said Joseph H. Prince Executor of This Adams have leave to invest the said sum of money or any part thereof in interest bearing bonds, or certificates of the Confederate States, or of the State of Virginia, the said bonds or certificates, if practicable, to be taken in the name of the said Executor in his fiduciary character, preserving the bonds theretaken, upon which he shall exercise due diligence in collecting the interest accruing thereon and in making a proper application thereof Given under my hand, in execution this 3^d day November 1863.
