Ordered the Road from the Blackhead signpost to Adams Pines gate be added to the road of which Joseph Pines is Surveyor.

Ordered that John S. Holmes who was appointed at August Court as the agent of the County to negotiate a loan for and in the name of the County of the sum of twelve thousand dollars for the purpose of purchasing the same for the use of the inhabitants of this County is hereby authorized to borrow the further sum of Six thousand dollars to pay the transportation of said Salt to and he is authorized to open the negotiable notes of this County for the same or any part payable in ninety days on current funds or on post funds as may be receivable in payment of Public Taxes and Commissions by the Presiding Justice -

Ordered that James H. Jones & D. S. Dole Esqs of the Commissioners of Roads for this County do let to the lowest bidder under the repairs of Seacocks bridge, under the same when completed & make report to Court.

On the motion of Joseph H. Pinner Executor of Theophilus Adams dec'd his petition to the Judge of the Circuit Court of this Court and the order of the Judge thereon is ordered to entered on the minutes and is in the words following to wit -

To the Honorable Richard H. Baker - Your petitioner Joseph H. Pinner Executor of Theophilus Adams dec'd respectfully represents to your honor that as such fiduciary he has in his hands the sum of Seventeen hundred (\$1700) dollars which he is unable to lend out or pay over to the party entitled (the being an infant and no guardian yet appointed) Your petitioner therefore asks that you have make an order authorizing him to invest the said sum of \$1700 in interest bearing bonds, or certificates of the Confederate States or of the State of Virginia - Joseph H. Pinner Exor. of Theo. Adams dec'd.

Upon the petition of Joseph H. Pinner Executor of Theophilus Adams dec'd representing that as such Exor. he is in possession of the sum of Seventeen hundred dollars (\$1700) which he is unable to pay over to the party entitled (the being an infant and that he desires to invest the same pursuant to the Act of Assembly passed March 5. 1863, he is therefore ordered that the said Joseph H. Pinner Executor of Theo. Adams have leave to invest the said sum of money or any part thereof in interest bearing bonds, or certificates of the Confederate States, or of the State of Virginia, the said bonds or certificates, if practicable to be taken in the name of the said Executor in his fiduciary character, providing the bonds thus taken, upon which he shall exercise due diligence in collecting the interest accruing thereon and in making a proper application thereof Given under my hand, in vacation this 3<sup>d</sup> day November 1863. Ordered that Benjamin Wilton be appointed an agent whose duty it shall be to visit the soldiers in military service from this County once in every two months and take to them such articles as may be sent by their friends and render to them such other services of courtesy and kindness as may be in his power. The County will pay all necessary expenses to the said Wilton and for the transportation of all such other articles as may be necessary.
