

Ordered that George C. Pope and Thomas P. Patton be appointed Agents whose duty it shall be to purchase at the expense and on account of the County, the said Corn (ten thousand pounds of peck and one hundred barrels of corn for the use of the families of soldiers now in service or who may have died or been disabled therein, for the East side of Nottoway River. And the said Patton the like amount of ten thousand pounds of peck and one hundred barrels of corn for the like purposes on the East side of Nottoway River. The said Patton be required to furnish to the County twenty pounds of marketable bacon for every hundred pounds of peck he purchases well cured and in good order, to be delivered at their respective farms during the year ensuing, at such time and in such quantities as may be required by the Commissioners appointed in each Magisterial District to provide for the support of the poor and of the soldiers, the quality of said bacon to be judged of by the said Commissioners. The corn so purchased is to be delivered in equal quantities at some convenient place in each district allowing one hundred barrels to each side of Nottoway River, as soon as practicable. They are further authorized to hire such wagons and horses as may be necessary to comply with the conditions of this order on the best terms practicable not exceeding thirty cents per day for each wagon and horse. But all proceedings under this order shall be void until said Agents shall have entered into bonds each in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars in the Clerk's Office of this Court with sufficient security for due faithful performance of the conditions of this order. And they are required to report to Court. And it is further ordered that the Overseers of the poor for each Magisterial district shall draw their orders for the support of the poor upon the Commissioners in each district for the support of soldiers families -

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
