

Ordered that George G. Peppin and Thomas J. Proctor be appointed Agents whose duty it shall be to purchase of the expenses and on account of the County, the said Peppin to purchase one hundred pounds of pork and one hundred barrels of Corn for the use of the families of soldiers held
now in service or who may have died or been disabled therein, for the East side of Netheray River. And the said Proctor the like amount of ten thousand pounds of pork and two hundred barrels of Corn for the like purposes on the East side of Netheray River. The said Proctor is also
to furnish to the County forty pounds of marketable bacon for every hundred pounds of pork to
be furnished well cured and in good order, to be delivered at their respective rates during the
year ensuing, at such time and in such quantities as may be required by the Commissioners
appointed in each Magisterial District to provide for the support of the families of eligible
soldiers, the quality of said bacon to be judged of by the said Commissioners
the case so purchased is to be delivered in equal quantities at some convenient time from
district allowing one hundred barrels to each side of Netheray River, to be sent as far
as might be necessary to comply with the conditions of this order on the best terms practicable and to pay
the same to the said Agents as agents holding the County therefor payable in Confederate or Slave money until
the time of payment. But all proceedings under this order shall be void until said Agents shall have given
bonds each in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars in the Clerk's Office of this Court with sufficient Sureties for
faithful performance of the condition of this order. And they are required to report to Court. And it is further ordered
that the Overseers of the Poor for each Magisterial district shall draw their orders for the support of the families of
the Commissioners in each district for the support of soldiers families -

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
