Wadley administration on Allen Safford estate having severally been on month and upwards in the Clerks Office, and there being no exceptions thereto were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

Wadleys Guardianship of Richard H. Parker, of W. A. Proffers Guardianship of John C. Whereupon on the motion of John Albert H. Turner who made with and together with James C. P. Turner & Providence L. Turner her administrators who justifies in oath as to their Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars conditioned according to law, certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration with the Will annexed on the estate of the said Edward P. Turner deceased in due form.

Ordered that Joseph of James, James R. Porem, Joseph W. Cloud and David Swain as any three of them being first duly sworn for that purpose do execute all charges & exchequer of Edward P. Turner, his and others estate & appointment until they have to the Clerk of this Court.

On the motion of Thomas M. Joyner who produces proof of his adoption and of his being in regular communication with the children between and the said land and Secretary according to law, he is hereby authorized to execute the said marriage.
