Deed of Gift from Norfleet L. Pond to Thomas R. Pond, dated 24th day of November 1863, conveying real & personal estate, was admitted to record 24th day of November 1863.

The account of George W. Vicks administration on Samuel Highmont estate, of Joseph H. Pinner Executor on Cephalus Adams estate, of E. L. Hays administration on D. E. Hays estate, of George W. Vicks administration on James Griggs estate, of Henry D. Badley administration on Allen Badley estate having severally been examined and approved in the Clerk's Office, and there being no exceptions thereto were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

The account of Richards F. Dilgards Guardianship of Albert L. Nugent, of Edward P. Badley Guardianship of Anna E. Badley, Samuel H. Badley, Charles E. Badley, Deborah E. Badley, of John B. Wiggins Guardianship of Richard H. Parker, of W. A. Proffers Guardianship of John C. Griffin having been examined and approved in the Clerk's Office and there being no exceptions thereto were severally examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

The account of Charles F. Vignards Guardianship of Francis M. & Maggie M. Vignards having been examined in the Clerk's Office and there being no exceptions thereto were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of William Joyner who made out together with John H. Hendrix two several and joint affidavits in and to his sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars conditioned according to law, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Richard C. Joyner deceased in due form.

Joseph H. Pinner the Executor named in the last Will and Testament of Edward P. Turner deceased refused to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof. Whereupon on the motion of Lady Abell M. Turner who made oath and together with James C. P. Turner & Benjamin H. Turner her co-executors who justified in and to their sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars conditioned according to law, certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Edward P. Turner deceased in due form.

Ordered that Mark A. James, James R. Pomeroy, Joseph W. Cloud and David Barker as any three of them being first duly sworn for the purpose to suppress all charges or claims of Edward P. Turner, did and stand in effectment until they have to the Clerk of this Court.

On the motion of Thomas M. Joyner who produced proof of his adoption and of his being in legal possession with the children between and who gave bond and security according to law, he is hereby authorized to celebrate the said marriage.
