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Deceit omitted as per decree filed.

Robert B. Postler salt Commissioner appointed to make sale of the boys of said debt the sum of \$1270. which was immediately paid over to Samuel Kelle Sheriff to be accounted for by him to the Court.

Ordered that the account of Elliot C. Ferguson amounting to \$1.95 be added to the bill of public accounts for his commission for year past.

On the motion of John B. Jenkins who made oath and together with Edward B. Cornfield & John B. Higgins his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) and who entered into and subscribed good and true in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Jeremiah Stuffed and in due form.

Ordered that Matthew N. Vaughan James Vaughan & Goodman C. Johnson being sworn for the purpose to appraise all the goods & chattels of Jeremiah Stuffed and return the appraised value under their hands to the Court.

Ordered that Samuel Kelle Sheriff of this County pay to Peter S. Holmes agent before array to pay for debt \$12.23 the amount in his hands, first deducting his Commissioner's fee and the said Peter S. Holmes receipt for the same.

Ordered that Peter S. Holmes the agent appointed at August Court 1863 and at present Court 1863 to neglect or fail for purchasing debt and for paying transportation money be and while he is aged to remain from time to time thereafter or which he may have committed under the order of the Court of said Court.
