This cause came on this day to be again heard on the papers formerly read and on the report of the Commissioners made at the last Term to which no exceptions are filed and was argued by counsel on consideration whereof the Court approving & confirming the said report doth adjudge, rule and decree that the costs of this suit be equally borne between the parties.

The last Will and Testament of John A. Person dec^d was proved by the oaths of Joseph A. Person and G. W. Musgrave the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the petition of James A. Person & James P. Person the Executors thereof named and made doth and together with John W. Whitehead, William C. Davis & Benjamin B. Davis their Securities (who justified our oaths as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two hundred thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, to be granted them for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.

Ordered that John Whitehead, May Jr. Turner, David A. Thomas & David Davis or any three of them being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of John A. Person dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

Ordered that Goodman & Johnson, Charles Waller, & Jones Swannam being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Eliza Person dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

On the petition of Wm. C. Gray guardian of Calum & Julia ordered that he be allowed to expend the sum of four hundred dollars out of the principal of the estate for the maintenance and clothing.
