Ordered that the State's debt (the County proportion) be distributed at large
that Robert W. Peeler be appointed Agent to distribute the debt due to Marcus G.

George F. & Ann Johnson, widow & wife of John Johnson, Esq^r with the apportionment of the County
should choose of James P. Bowles for their Guardian.

The Court of Sir Robert J. Bailey, according to Rebecca Raeford, widow of Allen Raeford
and the widow of his son and Robert J. Peeler her attorney who justified on oath to his
County who justified on oath as to his sufficiency, ordered unto and acknowledged above the
sum of One hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

On motion of Mrs. J. Norwood, Guardian of David H. Collier V & Edge S. Knudsen
he is authorized to receive One thousand dollars of the principal of each of his two Bonds and
for their support, education, etc.

On motion of Mr. H. Briggs, Beneficiary of Mary Pleasant Peeler that she pay Margaret J. Peeler
the sum of \$1595.75 of the amount of her account out of the money in her hands or be paid as is
in his hands.

On motion of Mr. H. Briggs, Guardian of the widow of Bray Saunders Ordered that he pay
Cordy Whitefield the sum of \$150.00 remitted to the money in her hands as it pays.

On motion of John M. Gurley, Guardian of William F. Johnson, Order that he return
sum of \$300 of the principal of his wife Esther for his support, education, etc.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the County to meet
of the next Term to consider any matter that may be brought before the Court concerning the
service from the County or their families or any member of any company and to part the
same.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of August Term.
