On motion of John J. Knickerbocker Guardian of David B. Selles V & Eliza C. Knickerbocker he is authorized to expend One thousand dollars of the principal of each of his said Bonds for their support, education, &c.

On motion of Mr. H. Briggs Guardian of Mary Rose Bonded that he pay Heywood B. the sum of \$295.75 of the amount of her account out of the moneys in his hands or so much as is in his hands.

On motion of John M. Gentry Guardian of William F. Gentry Ordered that he pay the sum of \$300 of the principal of his bonds Extra for his support, education, &c.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the County to be present at the next Term to consider any motion that may be brought before the Court concerning the service from this Court or their families in any matter in any way connected with the present case.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of August Term.
