

Advised J. Stephenson, administrator of Lawrence Briggs dec^d having filed his petition in the Court stating that he had invested \$1500. of his intestate estate in 8 per cent bonds and asking the Court to sanction the same. The Court said he might order and send down some confidential States Bonds to be sanctioned and assigned as the said administrator is directed to collect the interest in the same as it falls due and account for the same.

It is moved and seconded that the Sheriff so far as the County has funds be directed to make a special tender to each person holding bonds against the County if on the 1st of April of the present year it is only before the 1st of April in the next coming, and the Clerk of the Court is directed to post immediately a notice to this effect at the door of the Court house.

Samuel Wells Sheriff and administrator of James Pittman dec^d having filed his petition stating that he has advanced dollars belonging to James Pittman for which he now finds no investment. The Court said he might order and direct that Samuel Wells must \$1000 belonging to James Pittman's estate either in Confidential States Bonds or Virginia States Bonds and the said administrator is to take the said bond or bonds payable to himself as administrator and to collect the interest as it falls due and account for the same.

Ordered that Saml Wells Sheriff of this County take into his hand the estate of James Pittman, for and administer the same according to law.

Ordered that Richard L. Bryant grandson of Richard L. Worrell, appear for hundred dollars of the personalty of his ad^d mother's estate for a horse to be employed in the Military Service.

The Commissioners appointed to appraise Caroline Gardner her share in the real Estate of her late husband, John Gardner the day made an report.
