John D. Vick is appointed the agent of this County under the 5th Section of an Act of Assembly
passed March 9th 1864 entitled "An act to provide for the purchase and distribution among the people of
the State of Cotton, Cotton seeds, Cotton cloth and heavy coats" and the said agent is hereby authorized to purchase
of the State of Cotton, Cotton seeds, Cotton cloth and heavy coats worth of Cotton cloth & Cotton goods
to purchase for the use of the citizens of this County to the sum of five thousand dollars worth of Cotton cloth & Cotton goods
to be distributed by said agent among the citizens giving the said sum for the purchase of the same and
charges, including interest on advances, and all expenses of the agency. But the said John D. Vick is
not to act under the order until he shall have executed bond with good security in the penalty of fifty thousand
dollars conditioned for the faithful discharge of his duties as special agent. Whereupon the said John D. Vick
Vick Preble with Sam. Hills, John Hill & W. H. Cobb has been entered into and acknowledged a bond
in the penalty of fifty thousand dollars conditioned according to the above order. The said John D. Vick is hereby
authorized to borrow any amount of money he may deem necessary to pay for the said Cotton cloth & Cotton goods and make a
receipt for the County pay roll in ninety or sixty days or even after some time before as the said agent may
negotiable for the County pay roll in ninety or sixty days.
