sufficient to replace the money expended by said agents. And said agents are hereby authorized to borrow the
money necessary for the same and execute the notes of the County negotiable or otherwise and in writing
or after an act of the agents may deem necessary.

On the motion of Josephine Chatfield who made several affirmations and together with Zachariah
Royal & John Bellows his securities, who solemnly affirmed as to their sufficiency, witness unto and I
acknowledge above in the name of the County of New Haven my bond conditioned according to law certificate a
written herewith following letters of administration on the estate of Margaret Duperre in law
Court.

The County 10th day of April Alfred T. Stephenson guardian of Ann Eliza Digez widow of Sammuel
Digez Esq^r and his wife together with Wm. C. Prichard his Secy of the Justified on oath as to their
affairing) witness unto and acknowledge a bond in the sum of two thousand dollars conditioned
as follows directs.

Ordered that the Commissioners of the Revenue proceed to take a list of all the titheables
who have respectively tenth tenths all males above the age of sixteen years and the female slaves
not held up except such slaves and other persons as the Court may have excepted from taxes slaves
because of age infirmity or other charitable reasons.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the first day of the next
Term to consider the expediency of laying upon land and other property subject to State Tax within
the County, and on interest and profits mentioned in the 19th chapter of the laws in the year 1800
for the 57th section of the 35th chapter, on which taxes an aged ignorant person residing in the
County.

Ordered that the same be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
