

It is ordered that the Agents for the County Editors S. Hays & George & P. Hays purchase corn as the Sheriff to replace the money expended by said agents. And said agents are hereby authorized to borrow the money for the purpose and execute the notes of the County negotiable at their own and unrevoked.

On the motion of Jeremiah Chappell who made slanders affirmations and together with Jeremiah and John Doolittle his associates (who solemnly affirmed as to their sufficiency) entered into and granted him for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of Margaret Draper de. as law for.

The Court doth abjure Alfred T. Stephenson guardian of Ann Eliza Briggs of Tennessee as appearing) who is and acknowledges a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that the Commissioners of the Revenue proceed to take a list of all the titheables who their respective estates to wit, all males above the age of sixteen years and the female slaves above that age except bonds slaves and other persons as the Court may have exempted from taxes here because of age infirmity or other charitable reasons.

Ordered that the Sheriff Summons all the acting Justices of the County to the first day of the next Term to consider the expediency of laying upon lands within their property appraised with State taxes within the County and on interest and profits mentioned in the 19th Sec. yearly income in the 5th and the 5th Section of the 35th Chapter, ^{of the Legislature of 1860} on which taxes as aforesaid against persons residing in the County.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
