to collect the interest as it becomes due and account for the same according to law.

Ordered that John J. Bingham, W. C. Wynn, Edward R. Wells, M. B. Bennett & John
Pittman or any three of them do assign to Perry Branch widow of Jesse Bennett all the
one third interest of all the real estate of which she said Jesse Bennett was seized with
her personal estate, & make report to Court.

John C. Bower is appointed Surveyor of the road from Piney grove to Vick Church in the
name of Benj. R. Griffin caused And it is ordered that the usual bonds be made thereon.

Ordered that Edwin Harris & James R. Jagers two of the Commissioners of Roads let to the
lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge near Boykins Depot over Ferris Creek and
the bridge near O. Harris, receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

William R. Edwards returned on the 26th day of May 1864, duly elected Clerk of the County
Court of this County to serve as such for the term of six years commencing on the first day of
July 1864, and afterwards until his successor is qualified to enter upon the discharge of
the duties thereof, this day appeared in Court, and together with James D. Boyant, Richd. J.
Lusk & John J. Chambers his securities entered into & acknowledged a bond on the penalty
of Ten thousand dollars conditioned for the faithful execution of the duties of the office, which
bond is ordered to be recorded. And thereupon the said William R. Edwards took the several
oaths required by Law.

Richard B. Boyant, John Pittman, John Moore, Wm. A. Henson, Elijah J. Williams, George H.
Gardner & James L. Jones appeared in Court & qualified as Overseers of the Poor of this County
by taking the oaths required by Law.

On motion that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the first day of the
next Term of this Court to lay the County levy.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until the first day of August Term
