Ordered that the Sheriff collect from each free male person over the age of sixteen years, dwelling in, and born in all slaves lands and slaves property adjoined with slaves in this County, and on the interest and profits mentioned in the forty ninth section of the fifty first and thirteenth in the 57th sections of the 35 Chapter, on which was assessed against persons residing in this County one and one third per cent. Moreover the foreman of all returns and return the balance on his hands due just to this Justice of the peace upon any land, place, thing and other property, this year, the books adopted by the Board for the year 1863 as a basis for the levy on land, slaves & other property.

John J. Brattle who was on the 26th day of May 1864, elected Constable of the 7th District in this County this day with Catherine Brattle and Samuel B Kille his second, and he acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said John Brattle also took the several oaths provided by law.

Saml Kille Sheriff this day returned several lists of Insolvent County taxes amounting to \$285.00 which were examined and allowed by the Court.

Samuel Kille Sheriff of this County this day produced to the Court several lists of captives last one amounting to \$54.10 another amounting to \$32.87. another amounting to \$122.00 another amounting to \$112.00 verified by oath of the deputy Sheriff, and duly certified by the foreman of the Revenue and having been examined by the Court, and the Court being satisfied of the correctness of the same, and also satisfied that copies of said lists were posted up at the Court house door of this County on a Court day during the next two weeks preceding this term. It is ordered that copies thereof be certified to the first Auditor.

It is ordered that the Sheriff make a list of all the families of soldiers who had resided from the County, in each Magisterial District of this County, their number, ages and pecuniary condition and report to November Court next. For the performance of such duty hereafter present his claim to the County Court for payment.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned to the first day of the next Term.
