

Ordered that the Sheriff out of the money levied at July Court last pay Mr. T. R. Parker \$12.50 dollars for his services at attending physician of a small poor hospital.

Ordered that the Sheriff take into his hands the estate of Samuel Whitfield & Co., and administer the same according to Law -

Ordered that the Sheriff out of any Contingent money in his hands not otherwise appropriated pay to Mr. P. Popov the sum of \$25 for furnishing Money H. H. with provisions also \$1.50 as Surveyor's fees.

Ordered that the Sheriff out of any Contingent money in his hands pay Wm. D. 40 mills \$50. for provision furnished Elizabeth Parker.

A vacancy existing in District No. 1 of the number of O. Poor to which seat is entitled by reason of no election being held in said District, also a vacancy in District No. 2 by reason of George Boynton failing to qualify also in January their District No. 3 by reason of Samuel Vick failing to qualify also in District No. 6 by reason of W. H. Williams failing to qualify also in District No. 7 by reason of Benjamin Bill failing to qualify. It is ordered that Elections be held in said Districts on the 2^d Tuesday day of September 1864 for the election of O. Poor to supply said vacancies.
