

Ordered that the Sheriff out of the money laid at July Court last pay to Henry R. Parker \$12.50 dollars for his services at attending physician of a small pox hospital.

Ordered that the Sheriff take into his hands the estate of Samuel Whitehead deceased, and administer the same according to law.

Ordered that the Sheriff out of any contingent money in his hands at October Court appoint Henry H. Pope the sum of \$25 for furnishing Henry H. Pope with provisions also \$1.50 as Surgeon of road.

Ordered that the Sheriff out of any contingent money in his hands pay \$20. for provision furnished Elizabeth Parker.

A vacancy existing in District No. 1 of the number of O. Poor to which it is entitled by reason of an election being held in said District, also a vacancy in District No. 2 by reason of George Reynolds failing to qualify also in Jaynes their District No. 3 by reason of Samuel Vick - failing to qualify also in District No. 6 by reason of A. W. Williams failing to qualify also in District No. 7 by reason of Benjamin Bell failing to qualify. It is ordered that Elections be held in said Districts on the 23rd day of September 1864 for the election of O. Poor to supply said vacancies.
