On the motion of E. L. Story, John Cobb & Wm. H. Stickland, Securities for Wm. W. Cobb & Wm. A. Bell,
 Executors of James T. Batts dec'd. To give a new bond with security according to law. The Summons issued
 at the last term being returned, entered, the said Cobb & Bell appeared in Court and the parties being
 fully heard, it is considered by the Court that the said Cobb & Bell do execute a new bond with security
 for the faithful discharge of their duties as executors, and that they also pay the costs of this motion, and the
 said Cobb & Bell refusing to execute the said new bond, it is ordered that their powers and duties as
 executors be revoked and annulled.

Read at Robert B. Proctor a Justice of the Peace in the 7th District in this County this day tendered his resignation
 of said office, which resignation is accepted by the Court.

A Vacancy existing in District No. 7 in the number of Justices to which said District is entitled by
 reason of the resignation of Robert B. Proctor. It is ordered that the Commissioners & Conductors of
 Elections of said District assemble at Clarksville to be held on Saturday the 29th instant for the election
 of a Justice of the Peace for said District to supply bond vacancy.

On the motion of Wm. W. Cobb & Wm. A. Bell Executors of James T. Batts. Orders that
 the undistributed estate of the said James T. Batts dec'd be committed to the hands of Samuel Keller
 Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

 Stephenson in the 6th & John C. Griffin in the 7th District as agents for the County to purchase supplies
 for indigent families of Soldiers from exempt and detailed agriculturists, at prices not exceeding those
 paid at the time for like articles by the State Commissioners and appropriate these purchases exclu-
 sively to the use of said families - and the said agents are authorized to use the funds of the County not
 appropriated.

The Court appoint Joseph W. Glass, 1st Wm. M. Deaton, 2nd John H. Bishop, 3rd John Moore, 4th J. D.
 Proctor, 5th E. L. Story in 6th & P. J. Holmes in 7th District to distribute the supplies purchased for
 indigent families of Soldiers.

On the motion of Hardeck M. Clayton who made oath as together with Robert M. Dole &
 at J. Stephenson his securities who justifies an oath as to their suffering, entered into an acknowl-
 edged bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned according to law certified to
 grant him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James W. P. Clayton dec'd as
 before.

The Court doth appoint Alfred T. Stephenson guardian to his infant children Leah W. Stephenson
 & Martha R. Stephenson and thereupon the said Alfred T. Stephenson together with Robert M.
