Secretary of War to release from imprisonment the apple-brandy made in this

Ordered that she cannot be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.

On motion it is resolved that Mr. H. Paxton, ex-Deputy from this County to the Virginia Legislature, be requested to represent the condition of this County in improving upon itself, the burden of supporting the indigent families of soldiers and asking the State or Confederate Government to relieve it fully or to some extent.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
