to law.

Ordered that the Sheriff of the County and by Contingent monies in his hands & otherwise
appropriate pay to Joseph Gardner Commissioner of the Revenue five hundred dollars the
amount of his account for services rendered.

Ordered that Hon. Robert H. Whitfield member of Congress from the Second
District of Virginia be requested by the County Court of this County all of whose action
was summed and a majority being present to respectfully ask of the State
Secretary of War to decline from interfering the apple-brandy made in said

John Moore administrator of Mordy Smith who was authorized under an order
of September First 1863 to collect monies on his bonds which the creditors of said
the day made report which is ordered to be filed.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.

Ordered it is voted that Hon. B. R. Butler say the Delegate from this County to the Virginia Legislature
be requested to represent the condition of the County in imposing upon itself the burden of supporting
the indigent families of soldiers and asking the State or Confederate Government to contribute
or to some extent.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
