For a woman and foot 50 cts. Man there with or without load 75 cts. for carrying 100 lbs.

As above & his horse 25 cts.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the Court
to consider upon the purchase of supplies for the poor families the next year.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
