Court House the 16th day of January 1865.

S. B. Felle, Justices.

Hannah Whisfield for me, yesterday now, shall stand four pence dollars, per year a sum
or otherwise at the time of her payment to the Clerk of the Court house, every year during the apprenticeship.

On the motion of Mr. Miller Justice for me, for want of space for me to record her
will and testament of the age of 13 years Victoria L. Cheege of 3 years, Isaac of the age of 5 years
and of the age of 4 years, Robert of the age of 4 years to whom he left according to law.

Ordered that the Estate of Thomas W. Bell be committed to the hands of H. H. Gray
Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.
