

In this present, the intent to malice, design, desire or kill the said Edwards this day upon appeared
but according to the condition of his recognizance, and the Court having heard the evidence are of
opinion that there is not probable cause for charging of the said Alexander W. Storck with the
crime with which he stands charged. Therefore it is ordered that the said Alexander W. Storck be
exonerated from custody.

On the motion of Benjamin Weller and for reasons appearing to the Court he is except from the
payment of the sum levied against him for the year 1864.
