Dancy dec'd. that he is indebted to, and owes the sum of twenty five thousand dollars in his hands for the benefit of the said James, the sum of eight thousand dollars for Henry F. Mallory & the sum of Eight hundred dollars for the benefit of Anna Maria Mallory infant children of James B. Mallory, in Court of Wills, Executors & Administrators at his discretion, receive the interest at it became due and account for the same according to law -

On the return of James D. Bryant guardian of E. L. Everett Ordered that he be out of the principal of his ward's estate pay to John R. Rockwell the sum of \$250. the amount of his account -

On the return of James D. Bryant guardian of Caleb & Abner Everett Ordered that he be out of the principal of his ward's estate pay John R. Rockwell \$65 the amount of his account against Caleb and the like sum of \$25. the amount of his account against Abner Everett.

Ordered that W. H. Briggs Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of James C. Brighton dec'd. and administer the same according to law -

Ordered that W. H. Briggs Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of John H. P. Livingston dec'd. and administer the same according to law -

Shanks one of the Commissioners in Charge of this Court being now engaged on the public service which in the opinion of the Court prevents his being from attending to his duties as Commissioner the Court appoint John J. Hinderick a Special Commissioner to continue in office until the further order of the Court

On the return of W. H. Daugherty Administrator of Elijah Jagers dec'd. Ordered that he remit the sum of \$2500. moneys in his hands belonging to said Estate in non-Suable, his per cent fees (10%) (within law) or in some other bonds or Deeds at his discretion, receive the interest thereon at it becomes due and account for the same according to law -

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the first day of the next term to lay a levy for the benefit of the indigent families of the soldiers from this County -

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
